By entering the arena, you acknowledge that you are ACCEPTING THE RISK inherent in horseback riding activities. You are responsible for your own safety. The Hidden Hills Community Association, the City of Hidden Hills and the community of Hidden Hills assume no responsibility and cannot be held responsible for injury to horse or rider resulting from horse-related activities or use of the arenas or round pens.

- RESIDENTS HAVE PRIORITY OVER NONRESIDENTS. Nonresidents who are not accompanied by a resident must yield use of the arenas and round pens at a resident's request.
- Nonresidents may use the arenas only if (1) registered with the Hidden Hills Community Association and carrying an HHCA ID tag OR (2) accompanied by a resident.
- 3. Close the gates after entering and exiting.
- 4. No individual or group of riders has the right to monopolize the arenas. When safety concerns or other circumstances do not permit simultaneous use of an arena, be courteous and yield the arena to other residents within a reasonable period of time.
- Exclusive use rights belong only to the HHCA for clinics, horse shows, gymkhanas, team penning and similar HHCA sponsored activities.
- Be aware of other horses in the arena. Follow the rule of "left shoulder to left shoulder" when approaching an oncoming horse on the rail.
- Horses may be turned out in the arenas or round pens if the owner is present. However, riders have priority over turnouts and all other arena uses.
- 8. Do not ride in an unsafe manner that will excite or frighten other horses or riders.
- 9. Stallions are not allowed in the arenas or round pens when other horses are present.
- ASTM-SET-approved helmets are mandatory for children under the age of 18 and are recommended for adults.
- 11. All dogs in the area of the arenas or round pens must be on a leash at all times. Dogs are not allowed inside the arenas or round pens.
- 12. Keep the rails clear. Do not set jumps, poles, standards, cones, barrels, riding equipment or any other item along the rails. Any item left behind after exiting the arenas or round pens will be confiscated. Please close the gate after entering and exiting the arena.
