Seed Landcare Updates

- Irrigation for the slope will be done between January 28, 2019 and February 8, 2019.
- Planting will begin on February 11, 2019 and will take approximately 2 weeks to complete and will be completed by the end of February.
- Lynne will send pictures of plant choices to Melissa. Acacia on top row, Purple Restinga in the shady areas, and Purple Lantana filling in the bare areas.

New Business

- Will replant 2 of the community center pots to see if we like the style and plant choices.
- Lynne will re-do the proposals to include No-Mow, a blend of drought tolerant fescue that doesn't require mowing, along the small strips next to the sidewalk by the wall at City Hall.

Discussion Around Community Center / Saddle Creek Arena

- Add DG in front of parking spaces at Community Center. Relocate roses and add Star of Jasmine to other side of fencing in front of parking spaces. Obtain quote for trough at Community Center.
- Can concrete slab by the mailbox be removed from in front of parking spaces?
- Saddle Creek Arena Re-position Andy Gump. Blue Waste Management Trash Bins to be moved out of sight. Look into trash bins for the picnic bench area and arena, something nicer than the Waste Management Trash Bins.
