

**Parks and Recreation Committee**  
**Meeting Minutes**  
**April 8, 2020**  
**VIA Zoom Meeting**

Maggan Nord made a motion to approve the March 2020 meeting minutes and Liz Moses seconded the motion.

Welcome Party – Jennifer said the Board cancelled the Welcome Party that was scheduled for May 16<sup>th</sup>.
