

**Parks and Recreation Committee**  
**Meeting Minutes**  
**May 19, 2020 11:30 am**  
**VIA Zoom Meeting**

Drive In Movie-The Committee discussed having a community drive in movie. They talked about having the event at either Saddle Creek arena or the Round Meadow School parking lot. Jennifer said in addition to renting the movie system, she has a large screen and there is also a screen in the Parks & Recs. Closet that can be added for better viewing. The Committee will work on a budget that will come out of "mini events".

Hidden Hills Community Cookbook- The Committee discussed having residents submit their favorite family recipe to create a cookbook that the committee would sell to the residents. Katie will head this project since she has done one before. Oliva was also involved in creating a family cookbook.

Food Trucks- The Committee discussed having a food truck come twice per week. One at lunch time 11:00 am to 2:00 pm and a dinner truck from 4:00 pm to 7:00 pm. Liz said that she is hoping to get specialty food trucks like the Lobster and dumpling truck. The meals would have to be preordered and available for pick up only.
